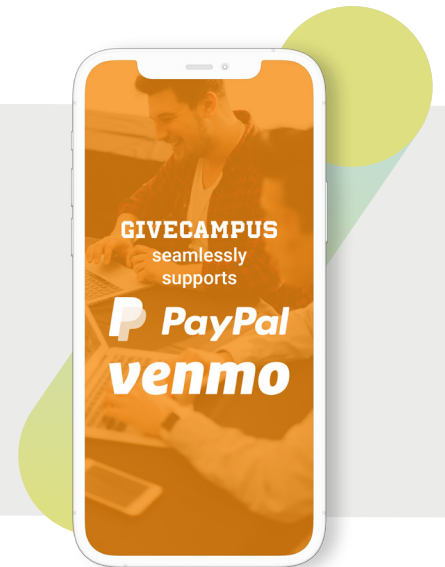


Why PayPal and Venmo are Better on GiveCampus

	GiveCampus	Other Platforms
Is the giving experience consistent, fast, and frictionless—no matter how a donor chooses to pay?	✓ YES!	NO. Donors may be redirected away from your giving form to complete payment.
Will your school automatically be approved to accept PayPal and Venmo gifts?	✓ YES!	NO. You have to apply, get accepted, set up your account, and then link your account to your platform.
Will your school name appear in Venmo feeds with each gift?	✓ YES!	NO. The vendor's name appears in the feed, not your school's name.
Will your donors AUTOMATICALLY receive a gift confirmation and tax receipt?	✓ YES!	NO. And that means more manual work for you and your staff.
Will 100% of funds get deposited directly into your school's bank account?	✓ YES!	NO. Funds pass through the vendor's account first.
Are gifts made with Paypal and Venmo included in donation and deposit reports by default?	✓ YES!	NO. You have to log in to PayPal and Venmo to download reports separately, then reconcile manually.
Does donation reporting include the donor's actual name (not just their Venmo username)?	✓ YES!	NO. You get the donor's username only and it's on you to try to match it to your database.
Does reporting also distinguish between PayPal and Venmo gifts?	✓ YES!	NO. You have to log in to PayPal to see if a gift is PayPal or Venmo.
Are PayPal and Venmo refunds managed right within the fundraising platform?	✓ YES!	NO. Refunds can only be initiated and managed by logging in to PayPal.
Can the platform also host other mobile wallets like Apple Pay and Google Pay? Or cryptocurrency?	✓ YES!	NOT LIKELY. Giving donors more ways to pay is a best practice, so be sure to ask.
Are donor-covered fees supported?	✓ YES!	NO. Most platforms actually limit payment options for donor-covered fees.
